3.4 Covid Information Update

There were no significant changes in how we operate.

Some changes include making sure kids have masks on when they enter the building, trying to be more careful when handwashing (not taking too much time and overlapping classes at the sinks). Otherwise, the school itself is spread out naturally and we do not need split recess or lunch breaks.

Questions from parents at the meeting:

Are kids sitting face to face?

We cannot change out furniture but have considered having students spread out within the classrooms when they are not needing to sit and work at their table.

Are students in the portables washing their hands with soap and water before meals: classes are all going through to wash hands before lunch. Hands are washed: first thing in the morning upon arrival, before and after eating snacks (both recess and lunch), and when coming in after the break. There are some instances when hand sanitizer is used instead, for instance, on an inside day when the students have not gone outside to get really dirty hand sanitizer may be used instead of soap and water. Are the frequent inside days because kids are coming in muddy and wet? The decision is not made lightly to keep them in, but yes, the previous week with all the snow and rain made outside days harder. It is not ideal to have cold shivering students trying to learn once back in class.

Before the break the school started mixing classes for P.E., is this still occurring? P.E. classes are back to individual classes

Are parent volunteers still allowed in the school? Parent Volunteers are allowed. Some teachers prefer to limit helpers in the classroom, others will likely keep going with helpers they have.

Does the school have enough masks to hand out? The school currently has a good supply of masks.

lain understands that rapid tests are coming to the school this week. Rapid tests are believed to be mostly for staff but may have some to hand out to families of symptomatic students. More information will come when they arrive.

3.5 Circle Garden phase 2 vote: request for \$3,723.15 by Mr. Gardner

Mr. Gardner is putting in a request

- At this point we are hoping for phase 1 and phase 2 to be completed at the same time. As weather and other delays continue to happen, Phase 1 construction has continued to be postponed.
- Phase 2 includes add six long poles around the bench, with a longer-term plan to incorporate a sensory walkway leading to the garden.

- Phase 1 involves prepping the ground by digging down and adding gravel, then constructing a raised garden and a circular bench.
- The reason for the 6 posts is to represent 6 cedar trees. This is in reference to a known to Cheam story; each post represents a different animal in this story.

A motion was put forward by Carla to use the remainder of the 2021/2022 gaming grant of \$2600.00 and fulfill the difference of \$1,123.15 from the general funds to support phase 2 of the Circle Garden
